CHAPTER 57

H.P. 1261 - L.D. 1771

Resolve, to Name the New Bridge Between the Cities of Bangor and Brewer the "Veterans' Remembrance Bridge."

Veterans' Remembrance Bridge. Resolved: That the newly constructed bridge between the Cities of Bangor and Brewer be named the "Veterans' Remembrance Bridge" and that an appropriate plaque be erected by the Department of Transportation near that bridge.

CHAPTER 58

H.P. 1455 - L.D. 2052

RESOLVE, for Laying of the County Taxes and Authorizing Expenditures of Sagadahoc County for the Year 1986.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, Sagadahoc County has certain expenses and liabilities which must be met as they become due; and

Whereas, it is necessary that the taxes for the year 1986 hereinafter mentioned be immediately assessed in order to provide the required revenue for the county; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Sec. 1. Sagadahoc County; taxes apportioned. Resolved: That the following sum is hereby granted as a tax on Sagadahoc County to be apportioned, assessed, collected and applied to the purposes of paying debts and necessary expenses of the county as authorized herein, and for other purposes of law, for the calendar year 1986:

Sec. 2. General Fund expenditures authorized. Resolved: That the following sums, based on the county budget filed in the office of the Secretary of State, are authorized as General Fund expenditures by the county during the calendar year 1986 in the specific total amounts of expenditures for personal services, contractual services, commodities and capital expenditures for each account in the county budget:
