CHAPTER 90

H.P. 1776 - L.D. 2453

Resolve, to Appropriate Additional Funds to
Commemorate the Bicentennial of the
United States Constitution.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Maine Commission to Commemorate the Bicentennial of the United States Constitution and the Office of the Bicentennial of the Constitution are charged with the duty of preparing a plan to interest and educate the public regarding our constitutional form of government; and

Whereas, coordination of local and statewide activities to commemorate the bicentennial is to be encouraged pursuant to Resolves 1985, chapter 85; and

Whereas, additional funds are immediately necessary in order for the commission and the office to carry out their purposes; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Appropriation. Resolved: That the sum of \$25,000 is appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of the Office of the Bicentennial of the Constitution, as created by Resolves 1985, chapter 85. These funds shall not lapse on June 30, 1987, but shall carry forward until the purposes of the office have been achieved.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Resolve shall take effect when approved.

Effective October 24, 1986.
