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**Sec. 3. Assistance.** The director of the bureau shall consult with and seek the advice of the Department of Marine Resources, the Department of Transportation, the United States Coast Guard and the United States Army Corps of Engineers, as necessary. In addition, the bureau may hire a marine salvage consultant to assist in this study.

**Sec. 4. Allocation.** The following funds are allocated from Other Special Revenue to carry out the purposes of this Act.
