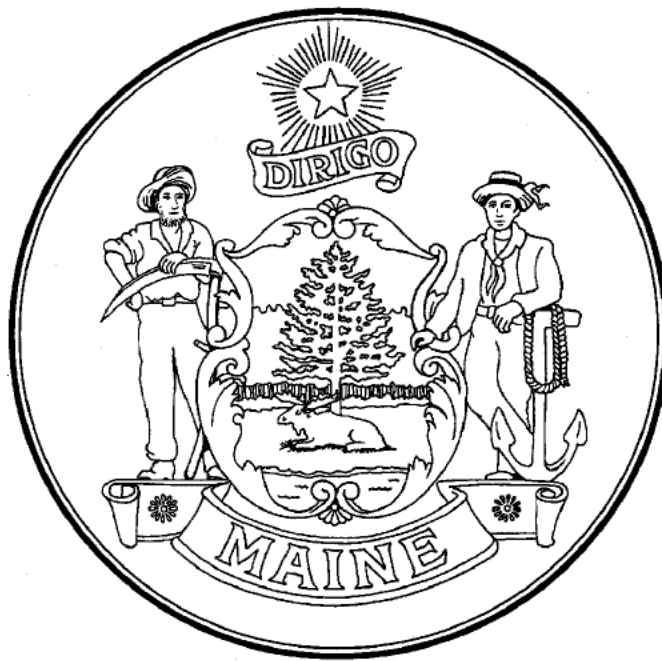

JANUARY 26, 1978

CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was held in the Speaker's office and called to order by Rep. John L. Martin, Chairman.
