LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
June 19, 1981

CALL TO ORDER

A meeting of the Legislative Council was held in Sen. Sewall's office and called to order by Chairman Elizabeth Mitchell at 10:30 a.m.

ROLL CALL

Senators: Sen. Collins, Sen. Conley, Sen. Pray, Sen. Sewall

Representatives: Rep. Diamond, Rep. Martin, Rep. Mitchell

OLD BUSINESS

An after deadline request was reconsidered with a new title, "AN ACT to Make Additional Corrections of Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine" sponsored by Sen. Devoe.

MOTION

It was moved that the request be voted upon.

The motion was seconded and voted upon with Rep. Martin, Rep. Mitchell, Rep. Diamond, Sen. Conley, Sen. Sewall, and Sen. Collins voting yea. Sen. Pray voting nay. The request was accepted.
