LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
February 10, 1982

CALL TO ORDER

A meeting of the Legislative Council was held in the Legislative Council Chambers, Room 327 and called to order by Chairman Elizabeth Mitchell at 2:15 p.m.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

MOTION

Sen. Pray moved that the minutes of February 3, 1982 be accepted.
