February 26, 1982

A meeting of the Legislative Council was held in the Legislative Council Chambers, Room 327 and called to order by Chairman Elizabeth Mitchell at 10:45 a.m.

NEW BUSINESS

A letter from William Garside, Legislative Administrative Director, concerning the Maine-Canadian Legislative Advisory Office, which was left out of a letter approved by the Council on February 24, 1982, requesting legislative employees salary adjustments, was submitted to the Council for approval. The adjustment would be as follows:

Adjustment of Salary Plan

Effective the pay week closest to July 1, 1981, the State shall pay the retirement contribution presently paid by those Legislative employees.

Employees may elect to receive a 5% salary increase in lieu of State payment of this retirement contribution.

Effective the pay week closest to July 1, 1982, the current salaries shall be adjusted to reflect an increase of 8% per week.

### MOTION

Rep. Martin moved that the salary plan for the Maine-Canadian Legislative Advisory Office be approved.

Rep. Diamond seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.
