LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
December 1, 1982

CALL TO ORDER

A meeting of the Legislative Council was held in the Legislative Council Chambers, Room 327 and called to order by Chairman Elizabeth Mitchell at 6:45 p.m.

ROLL CALL

NOMINATIONS

MOTION

Sen. Conley moved that Sen. Pray be nominated chairman.

Sen. Carpenter seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.

MOTION

Rep. Martin moved that nominations cease.

Sen. Collins seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.

MOTION

Sen. Carpenter moved that the a vote be taken to elect Sen. Pray, chairman.

Rep. Diamond seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.

At this time Rep. Mitchell handed the gavel to Chairman Pray to conduct the meeting.

MOTION

Rep. Diamond moved that Rep. Mitchell be nominated Vice-Chairman.

Sen. Carpenter seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.

MOTION

Rep. Martin moved that nominations cease.

Sen. Carpenter seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.

MOTION

Sen. Carpenter moved that a vote be taken to nominate Rep. Mitchell as Vice-chairman.

Rep. Martin seconded the motion and it was carried unanimously.

A "JOINT RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING the President of the United States, the Secretary of Commerce and the Maine Congressional Delegation Concerning the Current Hardships on Certain Maine Industries due to the Lack of a Fair and Equitable Trade Policies", sponsored by Sen. McBreairty was submitted to the Council for approval.
