LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

March 28, 1983

CALL TO ORDER

A meeting of the Legislative Council was held in the President of the Senate's Office and called to order by Chairman Charles P. Pray at 11:10 p.m.

NEW BUSINESS

The Personnel Committee submitted a recommendation to the Council requesting that they approve an increase in the Legislature's contribution to Legislative employees' health insurance premiums for dependent coverage to achieve consistency with all other State employees and that this increase be implemented effective with the next payroll. The proposed change would apply to both year-round and session employees.
