TITLE: AN ACT to Establish a Surtax on Fines.

COMMENTS: The State Police Academy has a budget of \$750,000 per year, \$550,000 from the General Fund and \$200,000 from Tuition. The total amount of money collected in fines and put in the General Fund last year was \$1.8 million dollars. A surtax of 12% would yield an income of \$216,000 which could eliminate the need for tuition and be a small tax relief for towns, cities, etc.
