RE: LISTING OF STUDIES

As mentioned by Speaker Saxl yesterday, enclosed for your review is a listing of all of the various study instruments that are still active. I'd like to thank Rose Breton, Dave Boulter and Grant Pennoyer for their work in pulling the various data together.

The listing includes 67 different study requests, including two that we learned about this morning. They are sorted in the following order:

- ➢ Committee;
- > the Committee's prioritization; then
- > the joint study order, LD #, etc.;
- specific data about the study request, including the number of members, number of meetings, report date, staffing, projected costs, etc.

In aggregate the studies would cost approximately \$500,000 in the upcoming biennium. To fund each committee's #1 priority would cost approximately \$100,000. Except as noted in the attached spreadsheet, there is *no funding* for these studies presently within the Legislature's 2002-2003 biennial budget.

Etta is in the midst of making a limited number of notebooks that include back-up on all of these study requests. Given some last minute changes in committee priorities that notebook will not be available until later this afternoon. We will deliver that to you as soon as possible.
