Review of Legislative Bill Requests

Requirements relevant to bills in the Second Regular Session

- 1. Under the terms of the Maine Constitution, Section 1 of Article IV, Part Third, Legislative Power, the business of the second regular session must be limited to budgetary matters; legislation in the Governor's call; legislation of an emergency nature admitted by the Legislature; legislation referred to committees to study and report by the Legislature in the first regular session; and legislation presented to the Legislature by written petition of the electors (direct citizen initiative).
- 2. Under the 121st Legislative Council's Rules of Procedure, any action of the Council requires the affirmative vote of at least 6 members.
- 3. Under Rule 203 of the Joint Rules of the 121st Legislature, any vote of the Legislative Council to accept or reject a bill or resolve for introduction under the procedures established under the Joint Rules must be taken by the yeas and nays, and that vote must be recorded and made available for public inspection.
- 4. Under Rule 217 of the Joint Rules, a bill that has been introduced and finally rejected in a regular or special session may not be introduced in a subsequent session of the same Legislature except by a vote of 2/3 of both chambers. Therefore, determinations as to the relevancy of Rule 217 are within the purview of the presiding officers, not the Legislative Council.

Suggested Protocol for deciding legislative bill requests

- A. The Legislative Council will review bill requests alphabetically by sponsor. An exception to this order of review will be made for bill requests for which an ASL Interpreter is required for persons who are deaf or hard of hearing. Those bills will be taken out of order at a time during the meeting when an interpreter is available.
- B. For procedural consistency, when voting on a bill request, the initial motion on a bill will be presumed to be a motion to accept the bill request for introduction into the second regular session along with a second to that motion. (Yea is to let in a bill; nay is to reject the bill for introduction).
- C. In order to review all legislative requests in a timely manner, voting will be by a show of hands, with each Council Member's vote on each bill being recorded. The record of each vote will be made available for public inspection following the meeting.
- D. If a bill request has been identified by the Revisor as requiring a ruling under Joint Rule 217, the Legislative Council may vote to accept that bill for introduction, conditional upon a subsequent ruling by the presiding officers. Absent a vote to accept the bill, the bill is presumed to have been turned down by a unanimous vote of the Legislative Council.

- E. Legislative sponsors and others are welcome to observe the Council's deliberations on the bill requests, but discussion of the requests will be confined to Council Members. Discussion of a bill request among Council Members will be limited to whether it is appropriate for introduction under Constitutional provisions for second regular session bills, and will not speak to the merits of the bill itself.
- F. If the Legislative Council turns down a bill request, a Legislator may appeal that decision, and at a subsequent meeting of the Legislative Council, the Legislator may speak briefly to the bill request under appeal.
- G. A legislative request that has been identified by the Revisor's Office as being closely related to another legislative request that was earlier filed (i.e., having been assigned a lower LR number) or to a carryover bill is presumed to have been turned down by a unanimous vote of the Legislative Council.

- TITLE: Resolve, To Reduce the Opportunities for Fraud and Identity Theft
- COMMENTS: This resolve would require the Secretary of State and the Attorney General to study issues surrounding access to documents such as birth certificates and prepare recommendations for a systematic statewide policy regarding such documents. The purpose of this resolve is to reduce the opportunity for identity theft and fraud.

- TITLE: An Act To Repeal the Taxation of Personal Property Valued Over \$1,000
- COMMENTS: Current law provides that personal property valued over \$1,000 be taxed locally at the municipality's tax rate. This bill would repeal that provision.

- TITLE: An Act To Authorize Certain School Children To Carry Asthma Inhalers on Their Persons
- COMMENTS: Currently, children in schools cannot personally carry their medications with them throughout the day. This bill would enact an exception to allow children to carry with them prescription asthma inhalers if a doctor has authorized in writing that the child is capable of administering the dose.

SPONSOR: Rep. Barstow of Gorham

- TITLE: Resolve, To Encourage Parents To Choose To Dedicate a Portion of Child Support Payments to College Investment Accounts
- COMMENTS: This bill would direct the Treasurer of State, in consultation with other appropriate state entities, to explore methods to encourage parents to choose to dedicate a portion of child support payments to college investment accounts.

TITLE: Resolve, Directing the Department of Public Safety To Examine Issues Surrounding Motorcycle Noise

COMMENTS: This bill would require the Department of Public Safety to review existing laws and ordinances governing noise emitted by motorcycles, and directs the department to report back to the Legislature its recommendations for a comprehensive statewide policy.

- TITLE: An Act To Require Computerization of the Chambers of the Maine Legislature
- COMMENTS: This bill would require the House and Senate chambers to be computerized by placing a computer on each Legislator's desk that could access bills, amendments, the calendar and other legislative papers.

- TITLE: An Act To Improve the Workers' Compensation Benefit Payment Process
- COMMENTS: This bill prevents the duplicate receipt of workers' compensation benefits and wages earned working for an employer that is not paying benefits to the employee under certain circumstances.

TITLE: An Act To Provide Tax-exempt Status to Nonprofit Businesses that Train Assistance Animals

COMMENTS: This bill would provide Maine tax exempt status to nonprofit organizations that train service animals and that are exempt from federal taxation under the United States Internal Revenue Code, Section 501(c)(3).

COMMENTS: This resolve would create an independent board of investigation to review the actions taken by the Department of Transportation regarding the Waldo-Hancock Bridge, including care and maintenance and any reports performed by the Department of Transportation over the past 40 years.

- COMMENTS: This bill would exempt public or private nonprofit organizations that provide transportation to persons of at least 65 years of age who decrease or stop driving or to persons with a visual impairment that prevents them from driving from vehicle dealer licensing requirements when those organizations accept donated vehicles.

TITLE: An Act To Amend the Cost-sharing Method Used in School Administrative District Number 57

COMMENTS: The formation of MSAD 57 was authorized by Private and Special Law 1995, chapter 93. The cost-sharing formula established for MSAD 57 is based on two factors: the pupil count of each member municipality; and the property valuation of each member municipality. Recent trends in pupil counts and property valuation among the member municipalities have resulted in an inequitable allocation of the shared costs of the district. This bill proposes to change the existing cost-sharing formula to a more equitable formula.

- TITLE: An Act To Correct the Maine Biomedical Research Program Definition of "Academic Medical Center"
- COMMENTS: This bill would correct the definition of "Academic Medical Center" within the Maine Biomedical Research Program. The correction is required to meet the legislative intent for competitive applications for biomedical research grant awards.

- TITLE: An Act To Obtain Severance Pay for the Employees of Great Northern Paper Company
- COMMENTS: This bill would require Inexcon of Maine to pay severance pay to the former employees of Great Northern Paper Company.

TITLE: An Act To Prohibit Remote Control Train Crews

COMMENTS: This bill would require all railroad trains in the State to operate with a minimum of 5 employees per train.

- TITLE: An Act Regarding Smoking in Stores That Primarily Sell Tobacco or Tobacco-related Products
- COMMENTS: This bill clarifies that smoking is not prohibited in a retail store under 2,000 square feet that primarily sells tobacco or tobacco-related products and also sells food and beverages to be consumed on the premises, including, but not limited to, spirits, wine and malt liquor, as long as its sales of tobacco and tobacco-related products account for at least 55% of its total sales.

TITLE: An Act To Provide for Fair Treatment of Taxpayers

COMMENTS: The purpose of this bill is to maintain the 6-year statute of limitations on assessments under the tax laws by reinstating the requirement that any additional tax liability be attributable to information that was required to be reported but was not reported in the return and to maintain the standard for determining the 50% threshold of the tax liability.

TITLE: An Act To Waive Fees for Background Checks for Certain Emergency Medical Services Personnel

COMMENTS: This bill would waive fees for background checks for emergency medical services personnel, municipal employees and volunteers applying for licensure.

- TITLE: An Act To Broaden the Definition of "Creditor" under the Maine Consumer Credit Code
- COMMENTS: This bill would broaden the definition of "creditor" under the Maine Consumer Credit Code to include those persons who extend credit on 10 or more auto loans and 2 or more loans on residential dwellings.

- TITLE: An Act To Streamline the Collection Process for Sanitary Districts
- COMMENTS: This bill allows sanitary districts to use the same process used by municipalities to collect real estate taxes from time-share estates when the districts collect charges levied against time-share estates.

- TITLE: An Act Regarding Increases in Fees, Charges or Assessments in a Mobile Home Park
- COMMENTS: This bill requires the owner or operator of a mobile home park to disclose in writing all expenses supporting an increase in a fee, charge or assessment occurring at any time after a mobile home dweller assumes occupancy and to provide to a mobile home owner upon request documentation supporting such an increase.

- TITLE: An Act To Require Owners and Operators of Snowmobiles and All-terrain Vehicles To Carry Liability Insurance
- COMMENTS: This bill requires an owner or operator of a snowmobile or an all-terrain vehicle to carry liability insurance in an amount equal to at least the amount required for an owner or operator of a motor vehicle.

TITLE: An Act To Provide Property Tax Relief to Maine Homeowners

COMMENTS: This bill would establish the Maine Homestead Property Tax Relief Program which incorporates the current Maine Residents Property Tax Program, the "circuit breaker" program, and a revised and beefed-up Homestead Property Tax Reimbursement Program. This new program provides direct state tax relief payments to all Maine resident property tax payers and doubles the amount of tax relief to homeowners. The bill would also authorize a local option property tax referendum to benefit long-time residents of a municipality.

TITLE: An Act To Promote Responsible Pet Ownership

COMMENTS: This bill establishes an income tax checkoff and a fund administered by the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources in conjunction with veterinarians' offices, humane societies and animal shelters to provide subsidies to low-income persons for the animal spaying and neutering of domestic animals.

TITLE: An Act To Honor Maine's First Peoples

COMMENTS: This bill creates a specialty registration plate for a member of a federally recognized tribe in this State. The plate must contain the term "Wabanaki," and the tribes will pay the deposit required before the production of specialty plates to the Secretary of State.

TITLE: An Act To Create the Maine Education Loan Forgiveness Program
