REVEREND HATCH: Before I pray, they have given me an opportunity to say a couple of remarks. I would just like to do that. But I look at the relative peace and the smooth transition in government and it makes me very thankful to be an American. As I look at some of the things that have divided us in the State of Maine, we still are able to speak to one another and deal with one another with respect. I think we have a lot to be thankful for. So, today, I just want to encourage you, as you go into your deliberations and the things that you'll be talking and sharing, the things that you're very committed to, to stop for just a moment and to be thankful. Before I pray today, I'd just like to have a moment of silence to give you an opportunity to just think about the things that God has blessed you with.

Our Heavenly Father, today we are thankful for the many blessings that You have given to us. I thank You for the privilege of coming and being able to share and to pray before this group of people. I am thankful as well, Lord, for the work that they are doing here in Augusta. Many of them have taken on a pretty significant responsibility. There are many demands on their time. They have few times of privacy. Phone calls at all times of the day and night from people demanding and wanting things from them. They come here with some very difficult problems before them. There are not easy solutions to many of the things that they face. I'm just thankful for their dedication and their willingness to serve us, the people in the State of Maine, in the way that they do. Lord, today there may be interruptions because of the weather conditions and the fact that many, perhaps, couldn't make it here today. We pray that You help them to seize the opportunities that are before them, that today might be a productive day for them. Lord, as they are servants of the people of the State of Maine, we pray that they might be willing to pass by party lines and go to state lines to represent the people in the State of Maine well. We ask for Your blessing on them today. Give them wisdom and strength. In Jesus' name. Amen.
