Tuesday, February 10, 1931.

The House met according to adjournment and was called to order by the Speaker.

Prayer by the Rev. Mr. Walker of

Gardiner.

Journal of the previous session read and approved.

Papers from the Senate disposed of in concurrence.

From the Senate: Bill an act relating to standard time. (S. P. 349) (L. D. 351)

Comes from the Senate referred to the committee on Judiciary.

In the House, on motion by Mr. Plummer of Portland, tabled pending reference in concurrence.

Orders

On motion by Mr. Jack of Lisbon,

Ordered, that there be printed 500 copies of the list and tables showing the amount of electric light and power company property returned to the Board of State Assessors, as filed with the House under date of February 4th.

Mr. Allen of Sanford presented the following order and moved its

Ordered, the Senate concurring. that any bills or resolves of a public character which were not pre-sented prior to February 10, 1931 be received and referred to appropriate committees if introduced between four o'clock in the afternoon of Tuesday, February 10, 1931 and four o'clock of the afternoon

Mr. Allen from the Committee on Education on Resolve providing for a teacher's pension for Fan-nie E. Keene of Waldoboro (H. P. 177) reported that same be referred to the Committee on Pensions.

Mr. Rogers from the Committee on State Lands and Forest Preservation reported ought not to pass on resolve authorizing the sale of a camp and lot known as Dudley Camp on the west shore of Moose-head Lake. (H. P. 27) Reports read and accepted and

sent up for concurrence.

Mr. Allen from the Committee on Education reported ought to Morelen Studley for teacher's pension. (H. P. 531)

Mr. Gagnon from the Committee on State Lands and Forest Preservation reported same on bill an act relating to the burning of brush, slash on blueberry land. (H. P. 669)

Mr. Melcher from same Committee reported same on resolve authorizing the Forest Commissioner to sell lands in St. Francis Plantation, Aroostook County. (H. P. 230)

Reports read and accepted and the bill and resolves ordered printed under the Joint Rules.

Mr. Tompkins from the Committee on Education reported ought to pass on bill an act relating to deductions from State School Fund. (H. P. 18) (L. D. 31)

Mr. Additon from same Committee reported same on bill an act relating to school attendance.

Reports read and accepted, and the bills having already been printed, were read twice under suspension of the rules and tomorrow assigned.
