SENATE

January 25, 1933 Senate called to order by the President

Praver by the Rev. L. D. Porter of Gardiner.

Journal of Tuesday, January 24th, read and approved.

Papers from the House disposed of in concurrence.

From the House:

Resolve providing for the com-pletion of Route No. 139. (H. P. 140) In the House, referred to the Committee on Ways and Bridges.

In the Senate, on motion by Mr. Littlefield of York, tabled pending reference in concurrence,

The following bill was received and on recommendation by the committee on reference of bills was referred to the following committee:

Agriculture

Mr. Story of Aroostook: An Act to assure proper branding of potatoes. (S. P. 77).

(500 copies ordered printed.) Sent down for concurrence.

The PRESIDENT: The Senate will recess until the sound of the gavel.

After Recess

The Senate was called to order by the President.

(Emergency Measure)

Out of order and under suspen-sion of the rules. "An Act to empower the county commissioners of Hancock County to construct a highway and raise money for the same." (S. P. 35, L. D. 9). Which act being an emergency

measure, and having received the affirmative vote of 29 members of the Senate, was passed to be enacted, and having been signed by the President was by the Secretary presented to the Governor for his approval.

(Emergency Measure)

Out of order and under suspension of the rules. "An Act to amend Section 110 of Chapter 5 of the Revised Statutes of Maine for 1930.'

(S. P. 36. L. D. 11). Which act being an emergency measure, and having received the affirmative vote of 29 members of the Senate, was passed to be enacted, and having been signed by the President was by the Secretary presented to the Governor for his approval.

On motion by Mr. Littlefield of York, the Senate voted to take from the table. Resolve providing for the completion of Route No. 139. (H. P. 140), tabled by that Senator earlier in today's session pending reference in concurrence; and on further motion by the same Senator the resolve was referred to the Committee on Ways and Bridges in concurrence.

On motion by Mr. Robie of Cumberland, the Senate voted to take from the table, Order relative to providing each officer and member with a copy of the Revised Statutes, tabled by that Senator on January 19th pending consideration; and on further motion by the same Senator the order was restored to the files of the Senate.

The PRESIDENT: Is there any further business to come before the Senate?

On motion by Mr. Pillsbury of Kennebec.
