Joint Order, That the Joint Standing Committee on Taxation report out a bill to the House to provide additional relief under the Elderly Householders Tax and Rent Refund Act and Low Cost Drug Program which will increase by \$1,000 the income limitation levels for eligibility under each program and cost the state \$1,085,000. Presented by Rep. Hayden of Durham; Co-sponsored by Rep. Higgins of Portland, Rep. Day of Westbrook, Rep. Masterman of Milo. Failed Passage in Concurrence 12-9-81.
