LD 157 / HP0109

An Act to Prohibit Fingerprinting by Merchants in Negotiation of Checks. Presented by Rep. Beaulieu of Portland; Co-sponsored by Rep. Hanson of Kennebunkport. Business Legislation Hearing 1-27-81. (Majority O.N.T.P. Accepted by Senate) (Minority O.T.P. Accepted by House). In House - Adhered to Engrossing; In Senate - Adhered to O.N.T.P. Died Between Houses.
