LD 169 / HP0143

An Act Concerning the Use of Force to Protect Property. Presented by Rep. Crowley of Stockton Springs. Judiciary Hearing 1-28-81. Majority O.N.T.P. Accepted by Senate; Minority OTP-AM Accepted by House. In House - Engrossed as Amended; In Senate - Adhered to Majority Report. Died Between Houses.
