LD 172 / HP0146

An Act to Authorize Municipal Ordinances Preventing Drinking in Public. Presented by Rep. McSweeney of Old Orchard Beach; Co-sponsored by Rep. Stevenson of Unity, Rep. Murphy of Kennebunk, Sen. Kerry of York. Legal Affairs Hearing 3-17-81. Majority O.T.P. Accepted by House; Minority O.N.T.P. Accepted by Senate. In House - Indefinitely Postponed. Died Between Houses.
