LD 306 / HP0274

An Act to Permit Blood Specimens to be Taken to Determine Blood-Alcohol Level Without the Defendant's Consent when the Defendant is Unconscious or Unable to Give Consent. Presented by Rep. Kany of Waterville. Judiciary Hearing 2-5-81. Majority O.N.T.P. Accepted by Senate (Minority O.T.P.). In House - Indefinitely Postponed. Died Between Houses.
