An Act Requiring Protective Headgear for Motorcycle Riders. Presented by Rep. Tuttle of Sanford; Co-sponsored by Rep. Diamond of Windham, Rep. Carroll of Limerick, Rep. Pearson of Old Town. Transportation Hearing 4-1-81. Majority O.N.T.P. Accepted by Senate; Minority O.T.P. In House - Indefinitely Postponed. Died Between Houses.
