Resolution, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Change the Term of Office of the Attorney General from Two Years to Four Years Beginning December, 1984. Presented by Rep. Murphy of Kennebunk; Co-sponsored by Rep. Diamond of Bangor, Rep. Kane of So. Portland. State Government Hearing 2-20-81. Majority O.N.T.P. Accepted (Minority OTP-AM).
