LD 559 / HP0508

Resolution, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Change the Term of Office for State Legislators from Two Years to Four Years. Presented by Rep. Nelson of Portland; Co-sponsored by Rep. Cox of Brewer. State Government Hearing 2-25-81. Majority O.N.T.P. Accepted by Senate; Minority O.T.P. In House - Indefinitely Postponed. Died Between Houses.
