LD 617 / SP0230

Joint Resolution to Ratify an Amendment to the Federal Constitution to Provide for Representation of the District of Columbia in the Congress. Presented by Sen. Trotzky of Penobscot; Co-sponsored by Sen. Conley of Cumberland, Rep. Masterton of Cape Elizabeth, Rep. Rolde of York. State Government Hearing 3-25-81. Majority O.T.P. Accepted by House; Minority O.N.T.P. Accepted by Senate. In House - Ought to be Adopted; In Senate - Adhered to Minority Report. Died Between Houses.
