LD 685 / HP0608

Resolution, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Require that for Certain Counties, a Specific Percentage of the Population be Included in a Separate Senate District. Presented by Rep. Webster of Farmington. State Government Hearing 2-25-81. Majority O.N.T.P. Accepted by Senate; Minority O.T.P. Accepted by House. In House - Adhered to Engrossing; In Senate - Adhered to Majority Report. Died Between Houses.
