An Act Relating to Arbitration under the State Employees Labor Relations Act. Presented by Rep. Jalbert of Lewiston; Co-sponsored by Rep. Paradis of Augusta. Labor Hearing 4-15-81. Majority O.T.P.; Minority O.N.T.P. Accepted by Senate. In House - Indefinitely Postponed. Died Between Houses.
