LD 961 / SP0331

An Act to Include the Term "Sexual or Affectional Orientation" in the Maine Human Rights Act. Presented by Sen. Conley of Cumberland; Co-sponsored by Rep. Connolly of Portland, Rep. Baker of Portland, Rep. Benoit of So. Portland. Judiciary Hearing 4-9-81. Majority O.N.T.P. Accepted by Senate; Minority O.T.P. In House - Indefinitely Postponed. Died Between Houses.
