An Act Concerning Gifted and Talented Education. Presented by Rep. Nelson of Portland; Co-sponsored by Rep. Boyce of Auburn, Rep. Thompson of So. Portland, Sen. Trotzky of Penobscot. Education Hearing 3-9-81. Majority O.T.P. Accepted (Minority O.N.T.P.). Indefinitely Postponed.
