LD 1011 / HP0845

An Act to Implement Certain Cost Savings while the State's Unemployment Compensation Fund Remains in Debt. Presented by Rep. Dexter of Kingfield; Co-sponsored by Rep. Cunningham of New Gloucester. Labor Hearing 3-19-81. OTP-AM Accepted. Amended by: CA H-169. Emerg. Enacted. Vetoed by Governor; veto sustained in House.

Joint Order, That Bill "An Act to Implement Certain Cost Savings while the State's Unemployment Compensation Fund Remains in Debt" (HP 845) (LD 1011) be recalled from the Governor's desk to the House. Presented by Rep. Beaulieu of Portland. Indefinitely Postponed in Concurrence 4-28-81.
