LD 1044 / HP0875

An Act to Exempt Illegal Possession of Liquor from the Maine Juvenile Code. Presented by Rep. Conary of Oakland; Co-sponsored by Rep. Jacques of Waterville, Rep. McSweeney of Old Orchard Beach. Judiciary Hearing 3-26-81. Majority O.N.T.P. Accepted by Senate; Minority O.T.P. Accepted by House. In House - Insist, Conf. Asked; In Senate - Adhered to Majority Report. Died Between Houses.
