An Act to Provide Occupational Safeguards for Operators of Video Display Terminals. Presented by Rep. Beaulieu of Portland. Labor Hearing 4-22-81. Majority OTP-ND (HP1482 / LD 1612); Minority O.N.T.P. Accepted by Senate. In House - Indefinitely Postponed. Died Between Houses.
