LD 1086 / SP0367

An Act to Bring Noncarbonated Beverages such as Fruit Punch and Iced Tea into Compliance with Maine's Beverage Container Law. Presented by Sen. Ault of Kennebec. Business Legislation Hearing 4-23-81. Majority O.N.T.P. Accepted by House; Minority OTP-AM Accepted by Senate. In House - Adhered to Majority Report; In Senate - Adhered to Minority Report. Died Between Houses
