History and Final Disposition

LD 1201 / HP1003

An Act to Prohibit Registration within 72 Hours of an Election. Presented by Rep. Hutchings of Lincolnville; Co-sponsored by Rep. Curtis of Waldoboro, Rep. Cahill of Woolwich. Election Laws Hearing 3-31-81. Majority O.N.T.P. Minority O.T.P. Accepted by Senate. In House - Bill Violates Joint Rules; In Senate - Engrossed. Died Between Houses.
