LD 1305 / SP0457

An Act to Provide a Right-of-way to Pedestrians Against Drivers Entering Private Ways. Presented by Sen. O'Leary of Oxford. Transportation Hearing 4-15-81. Majority O.T.P. Accepted (Minority O.N.T.P.). In House - Adhered to Failed to Enact; In Senate - Enacted. Died Between Houses.
