LD 1694 / HP1705

Resolution, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine to Decrease the Bonding Limit of the Maine School Building Authority from \$10,000,000 to \$6,000,000. Presented by Rep. Diamond of Windham; Co-sponsored by Rep. Higgins of Scarborough. Appropriations & Financial Affairs. Engrossed Without Reference. Finally Passed, CON RES LAWS, Chapt. 3. Approved in Referendum, 11-3-81 (In favor: 143,962; Opposed: 80,300).
