Resolve, Reimbursing Great Pond on Account of Taxes Lost Due to Lands Being Classified Under the Maine Tree Growth Tax Law. Presented by Rep. Post of Owls Head. Taxation Hearing 1-21-82. O.T.P. Accepted. In House - Enacted; In Senate - Referred to Appropriations & Financial Affairs Committee. Died Between Houses. (Cf. LD 2145, Pt. A)
