LD 1871 / HP1878

An Act to Provide Flexibility with Respect to the School Entrance Age. Presented by Rep. Connolly of Portland; Co-sponsored by Rep. Baker of Portland. Education Hearing 2-24-82. Majority OTP-AM; Minority O.N.T.P. Accepted by House. In Senate - Indefinitely Postponed. Died Between Houses.
