LD 1877 / HP1891

An Act to Provide Retired Teachers, State Employees and Beneficiaries with a Cost-of-living Increase. Presented by Rep. Diamond of Windham; Co-sponsored by Rep. Pearson of Old Town, Sen. Pierce of Kennebec, Sen. Teague of Somerset. Aging, Retirement & Veterans Hearing 2-23-82. OTP-AM Accepted. Amended by: CA H-679. In House - Enacted; In Senate - Referred to Appropriations & Financial Affairs Committee. Died Between Houses. (Cf. LD 2144, Pt. Q)
