An Act to Equalize the Price of Liquor throughout the State. (Reported pursuant to Study Order.) Legal Affairs Hearing 2-25-82. Majority OTP-AM; Minority O.N.T.P. Accepted by Senate. In House - Indefinitely Postponed. Died Between Houses.
