An Act to Authorize the Repair, Maintenance and Improvement of the Building and Grounds of the Statehouse. Presented by Rep. Lund of Augusta; Co-sponsored by Rep. Hickey of Augusta, Sen. Clark of Cumberland, Sen. Ault of Kennebec. State Government Hearing 3-10-82. OTP-AM Accepted. Amended by: CA H-655. In House - Adhered to Enactment; In Senate - Referred to Appropriations & Financial Affairs Committee. Died Between Houses.
