An Act Making Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1982 and June 30, 1983. Presented by Rep. Pearson of Old Town; Co-sponsored by Sen. Huber of Cumberland. Appropriations & Financial Affairs. Amended by: HD H-780. Emerg. Enacted, Approved 5-4-82, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapt. 702.
