Joint Resolution Memorializing Congress and the President of the United States to Act Quickly to Extend the Sunset Date on the Provisions of Federal Law Which Authorize States to Use Tax-exempt Mortgage Revenue Bonds to Provide Mortgage Capital for Single Family Home Buyers, Thus Continuing the Availability of Affordable Mortgage Capital Critical to the Well-being of the State and Nation. Presented by Speaker Martin of Eagle Lake; Co-sponsored by Sen. Conley of Cumberland, Sen. Violette of Aroostook, Rep. Gwadosky of Fairfield. Adopted in Concurrence, 1-24-84.
