LD 207 / HP0178

An Act to Permit Bowling Alleys to Sell Spirituous, Vinous and Malt Liquor. Presented by Rep. Dillenback of Cumberland; Co-sponsored by Rep. Salsbury of Bar Harbor. Legal Affairs Hearing 2-2-83. Majority O.T.P. Accepted (Minority O.N.T.P.). In House - Adhered to Failed to Engross; In Senate - Engrossed. Died Between Houses.
