LD 235 / SP0103

An Act to Change the Date of the Primary Election to the First Tuesday in September. Presented by Sen. Diamond of Cumberland; Co-sponsored by Rep. McGowan of Pittsfield, Sen. Pray of Penobscot, Sen. Pearson of Penobscot. Election Laws Hearing 2-8-83. Majority OTP-AM Accepted by Senate; Minority O.N.T.P. Accepted by House. In House - Adhered to Minority Report; In Senate Insisted on Engrossed with CA. Died Between Houses.
