An Act to Require a Single License Plate. Presented by Rep. Baker of Portland; Co-sponsored by Rep. Nadeau of Lewiston, Rep. Paradis of Augusta. Transportation Hearing 4-6-83. Majority O.N.T.P. Accepted by Senate; Minority O.T.P. Accepted by House. In House - Failed Engrossed. Died Between Houses.
