LD 1354 / HP1029 (ND 1784 / HP1345)

An Act Making Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1984, and June 30, 1985. Presented by Rep. Carter of Winslow; Co-sponsored by Sen. Najarian of Cumberland. Appropriations & Financial Affairs Hearings 4-12-83, 5-3-83. Majority OTP-ND Accepted (Minority OTP-ND: HP1346 / LD 1785 NEW TITLE) NEW DRAFT: HP1345 / LD 1784. Enacted, Approved 6-23-83, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapter 477.

Joint Order, That the departments and agencies of the State are directed to use any and all available means to avoid the layoff or break in service of present State Employees due solely to the 90-day waiting period for PL 1983, chapt. 477, to become effective. Presented by Sen. Najarian of Cumberland. Passed in Concurrence, 6-24-83.
