Joint Resolution to Ratify an Amendment to the Constitution of the United States to Provide for a Delay in an Increase in Compensation to Members of Congress Until an Intervening Election of Representatives Has Occurred. Presented by Sen. Shute of Waldo; Co-sponsored by Sen. Hayes of Penobscot, Rep. Rolde of York, Rep. Masterton of Cape Elizabeth. State Government Hearing 4-21-83.
