LD 1553 / SP0530

An Act Relating to Major Policy-influencing Positions in Certain Regulatory and Law Enforcement Agencies. Presented by President Conley of Cumberland; Co-sponsored by Speaker Martin of Eagle Lake. State Government Hearing 5-17-83. Leave to Withdraw Accepted. Despite this report, this Bill was ordered held over to the next special or regular session of the 111th Legislature, pursuant to Joint Order (HP 1357). Leave to Withdraw Accepted.
