LD 1805 / SP0642

An Act Relating to the School Year for School Administrative District Number 57. Presented by Sen. Wood of York. Engrossed Without Reference. Emerg. Enacted. This Bill was Neither Signed nor Vetoed by the Governor. Pursuant to Joint Order (HP 1417), this bill was recalled from the Governor's Desk. Indefinitely Postponed.
