Presented by Rep. Cote of Auburn; Co-sponsored by Rep. Perry of Mexico, Rep.
McSweeney of Old Orchard Beach. Legal Affairs Hearing 1-25-84. O.T.P. Accepted.
Enacted, Approved 2-22-84, PUBLIC LAWS, Chapter 610.
